

Texas City Jaycees 2023 Scholarship Program

The Texas City Jaycees announces the 2023 **Texas City Jaycees Scholarship Program.** Under the Program, two (2) \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded to seniors attending La Marque High School.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

* Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.

* Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college, four (4)-year college or university, or technical school.

* Scholarship funds will be disbursed in equal payment in **August 2023 & January 2024 -directly to the college**, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall & spring semesters, which includes the Student ID number, transcript (from fall semester so spring funds can be issued), and Financial Aid Office address. This scholarship is not renewable.

* Students must continue to attend classes and maintain no lower than a 2.0 grade-point average (or equivalent).

* Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.

* Applications must be received by the Texas City Jaycees no later than <u>March 31, 2023</u>. Late applications will not be accepted.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the Texas City Jaycees Scholarship Committee. The scholarships will be awarded at the end of **May 2023** during the awards presentation at the LMHS Scholarship Ceremony.
